**NOTES:**

1. **Reader 1** signifies the reader for the *First Reading*, and the leader for the *Responsorial Psalm* if it is not cantored. **Reader 1** processes in alone, right in front of the priest, with the *Book of Gospels*, and joins Reader 2 at the reader's bench.  
(Deacon David/Mike will process in with the Book of Gospels when present).
2. **Reader 2** signifies the reader for the *Announcements*, *Second Reading* and the *Petitions*.  
(Deacon David/Mike reads the Petitions when present).  
**Reader 2** does not process in, but waits at the reader's bench after reading the *Announcements* to be joined by Reader 1. S/he takes the *Book of Gospels* from Father at the end of the Gospel reading.
3. **If only one reader and no Deacon**, the reader places the *Book of Gospels* in its stand on the altar, or gets a Eucharistic Minister to carry up the book. With, or without a Deacon, the reader reads the *Announcements*, does not process in with the others, and does the readings/tasks of both readers.

**-Always be prepared to read both parts in case your partner reader is unexpectedly absent. Please get substitutes or trade assignments as soon as possible. Everyone needs the maximum chance to reflect on and prepare for the readings. We have been asked not to share introductory thoughts prior to our reading or extra comments at the end.**

**-When you arrive at church, please locate and prepare the *Announcements* and check the *Lectiary* to be sure the marker is set correctly. Speak with the choir director to determine anything the choir plans (or doesn't plan) that might affect your reading.**

**PLEASE ARRIVE AT LEAST 15 MINUTES BEFORE MASS TIME.**
